## DENTAL ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

The following pre dental courses are mandatory. There are no substitutes for these prerequisites; they cannot be waived. *IUPUI course follows each prerequisite*

**English Composition - one semester**

ENG W 131

**General Chemistry\* - two semesters with lab**

CHEM C 105 (3 hrs) & C 125 (2 hrs) and

CHEM C 106 (3 hrs) & C 126 (2 hrs)

**Organic Chemistry\* - one semester with lab**

CHEM C341 (3 hrs) & CHEM C343 (2 hrs) and

CHEM C342 (3 hrs)

\*NOTE: The IU Dental School does not require CHEM C 342, but it is a pre-requisite for Biochemistry.

**Biology\* - two semesters with lab**

BIOL K 101 (5 hrs) and

BIOL K 103 (5 hrs)

**Physics\* - two semesters with lab**

PHYS P 201 (5 hrs) and PHYS P 202 (5 hrs) or

PHYS 21800 (4 hrs) and PHYS 21900 (4 hrs)

**Psychology - one course**

PSY B 110 (3 hrs)

**Anatomy\* - one semester with lab**

BIOL-N 261 (5 hrs)

**Physiology\* - one semester**

BIOL-N 217 (5 hrs)

**Biochemistry Lecture - one semester\***

CHEM C484 (3 hrs) or BIOL K483 (3 hrs) or BIOL K 484 (3 hrs)

Suggested electives:

Solid Art (such as jewelry-making courses), Introduction to Business Management, Genetics, Molecular Biology, Microbiology, Histology, Fluency in a foreign language, Social Science courses, and Humanities courses.

\* All required science courses except physiology and biochemistry must include labs. See your pre-professional advisor for details.

A minimum of **ninety (90)** semester hours of coursework must be completed by matriculation. At least **thirty (30)** semester hours must be completed at a four-year college. Applicants are encouraged to complete upper-level science courses at 4-year institutions (i.e. colleges or universities that grant bachelors degrees). Apply to the dental school one year in advance of entrance into the program.

**All prerequisites must have letter grades; no PASS/FAIL options are accepted.  
All science courses (except biochemistry and physiology) must include laboratories.  
All the prerequisites must be completed before matriculation to Dental School**

AADSAS verifies all transcripts; therefore you must send official transcripts from each college you attended directly to AADSAS. AADSAS will not forward your application until all your transcripts are received and verified.

The following supplementary material will be requested after IUSD receives your application from AADSAS:

Application fee (\$50.00 for U.S. students/\$60.00 for International students, make checks payable to IUPUI. This fee is non-refundable); &, Official Dental Admission Test (DAT) scores.

Because IUSD maintains a rolling admissions policy, you are encouraged to apply early. Therefore, in order for you application to be reviewed and considered for a fall interview, AADSAS should receive your application by July 15th.

The Admissions Committee expects applicants to have completed a minimum of **40 hours of exposure** to general practice dentistry in a private practice setting and significant and meaningful volunteerism, service and/or involvement in their communities or on their campuses.

All letters of evaluation must be sent directly to AADSAS. AADSAS will only process four letters of evaluation, therefore, IUSD will only accept three required academic letters of evaluation and one optional personal letter of evaluation. Evaluation letters must be submitted through AADSAS, letters sent directly to IUSD will not be accepted. Interviews will be granted to selected applicants only after the three (3) academic letters of evaluation, application fee, and DAT scores have been received by IU School of Dentistry.
